Noon on the 60th Day prior to the Special Election

This is a pretest ONLY and will be conducted by the Martin County Supervisor of Elections Office.

The Martin County Supervisor of Elections Office will provide a ballot for proof by the Town Clerk.

Must file reports on the 53th day immediately preceding the special election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the special election.

46 days, not less than 45 days prior to the Special Election

Must file reports on the 39th day immediately preceding the special election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the special election.

29th day prior to Special Election

Between 28-35 days prior to the Special Election

Must file reports on the 25th day immediately preceding the special election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the special election.

The canvassing board may begin the canvassing of absentee ballots at 7 a.m. on the 15th day before the election, but not later than noon on the day following the election.

Must file reports on the 11th day immediately preceding the special election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the special election.

Any contribution received by a candidate with opposition in an election or by the campaign treasurer or a deputy campaign treasurer of such a candidate on the day of that election or less than 5 days before the day of that election must be returned to him or her to the person or committee contributing it and may not be used or expended be or on behalf of the candidate.

Must file reports on the 4th day immediately preceding the special election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the special election.

Secure the election Equipmt.

A Special Meeting of the Town Council must be held and Canvass the returns.

The town shall, not later than noon of the second day after the election, furnish a certificate of election to each person shown to have been elected.

Must file reports on the 53th day immediately preceding the special election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the special election.

46 days, not less than 45 days prior to the Special Election

Must file reports on the 53th day immediately preceding the special election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the special election.

Between 28-35 days prior to the Special Election

29th day prior to Special Election

Must file reports on the 53th day immediately preceding the special election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the special election.

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A Special Meeting of the Town Council must be held and Canvass the returns.

The town shall, not later than noon of the second day after the election, furnish a certificate of election to each person shown to have been elected.
