ORDINANCE

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA, AMENDING TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT CODE OF ORDINANCES APPENDIX A-SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR COST DEPOSITS FOR MINOR SUBDIVISION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF TOWN EXPENSES ON BEHALF OF MINOR SUBDIVISION APPLICANTS; PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF ALL COSTS FROM SUBDIVISION DEVELOPERS TO THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT FOR ITS COSTS AND EXPENSES INCURRED ON BEHALF OF SUBDIVISION DEVELOPERS FOR PLATTING OF SUBDIVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR INSERTION IN THE TOWN CODE; PROVIDING REPEAL OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEPARATION IN THE EVENT A SECTION OR PORTION IS DECLARED TO BE UNCONSTITUTIONAL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Charter of the Town of Sewall's Point, styled Chapter 57-1865, Laws of Florida, and pursuant to Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, the Town of Sewall's Point has power to adopt subdivision regulations, and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission of the Town of Sewall's Point has determined that it is necessary and proper to set forth amendments to the comprehensive standard for the subdivision of land in the Town of Sewall's Point and for the filing of subdivision plats.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Commission of the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida, that:

I.

Appendix A-Subdivision Regulations, Town of Sewall's Point Code of Ordinances, Section B: Minor Subdivision Subsection 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

An application for approval of a minor subdivision shall be submitted to the Board at least ten (10) days prior to the regular meeting at which it is to be considered. The application shall be accompanied by a scaled reproducible drawing on paper no larger than 8½ inches by 14 inches and two copies

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prepared by a land surveyor. The drawing shall show:

- (a) Dimensions of the proposed lot.
- (b) Location of existing structures.
- (c) Location of existing and proposed roads, rights of way or easements used, or to be used, for access to all lots.

Along with submission with the application in the proper form and with the required survey, the applicant shall provide a copy of his deed, and \$75.00 cost deposit. The cost deposit shall be for costs incurred by the Town of Sewall's Point for such items as recording fee, or recording the approval of the Board, should same be given as required by Section 3 herein, engineering fees by Town Engineer, attorneys fees provided by Town Attorney, all of which are provided for the benefit of the applicant. There shall be no cost to the Town as a result of the application for minor subdivision.

The Board shall consider the application at its first regular meeting after submittal of the application, provided it has been submitted within the required time frame specified above.

The application must be approved by the Board before the property can be subdivided.

II.

Section C: Subdivisions, Section 1: Preliminary
Plan, the third paragraph thereof, is hereby amended to read
as follows:

The filing fee shall be \$50.00 for each lot shown on the preliminary plan or plat which shall be paid to the Town at the time the preliminary plat is tendered to the Town authorities and in the event the Town's engineering cost is less than the amount tendered, then in that event, a refund will be made to the subdivider and if the Town's engineering costs are more than the sum so tendered an additional payment will be due the Town. The matter of final cost will be determined as soon as possible, and, prior to the final

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approval and filing, final cost shall be paid by the developer.

It is the intent of the Board that the Town be reimbursed for all costs expended on behalf of the developer of any subdivision for any and all costs incurred for developer's benefit.

III.

Section C: Subdivisions, Section I: Preliminary
Plan, is hereby amended by the addition of the following last
paragraph to the Section as follows:

and a certificate of ownership from either a member of the

Florida Bar or a title insurance company with offices in Martin

County, Florida, indicating the name and current mailing address

and telephone number of the owner of the property comprising

the proposed subdivision. Where the developer is not the owner

of the property, an affidavit of the owner indicating that the

owner of the property concurs with the proposed subdivision of

the property is required.

Separation:

If any section, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held or declared to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding or invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and it shall be construed to have been the intent of the Board to adopt this Ordinance without such unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative part therein, and the remainder of this Ordinance after the exclusion of such part or parts, shall be deemed and held to be valid as if such part or parts had not been included herein. If this Ordinance or any provision thereof shall be held to be inapplicable to any person, groups of persons, property, kind of property, circumstances or set of circumstances, such holdings shall not affect its applicability to any other person, property or circumstances.

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Repeal:

Town ordinances and Town resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby abolished and repealed to the extent of such conflict.

V.

Incorporation in Town Code.

Provisions of this Ordinance shall be incorporated in the Town Code and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate word, and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention.

VI.

Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the date of its passage according to law.

Passed first reading at the regular meeting of the Town Commission held on the 9th day of April, 1980.

Passed second reading at the regular meeting of the Town Commission held on the 14th day of May, 1980.
