AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA, ASSESSING IN CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER COSTS, AN ADDITIONAL ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) TO BE USED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT EDUCATION AND TRAINING; PROVIDING FOR INSERTION IN THE TOWN CODE; PROVIDING REPEAL OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEPARATION IN THE EVENT A SECTION OR PORTION IS DECLARED TO BE UNCONSTITUTIONAL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has amended Florida Statute 943.25 allowing additional costs be assessed and said costs be utilized for Law Enforcement for Education and Training, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Sewall's Point desires to take advantage of the additional funds that would be made available for the education and training of its law enforcement officers.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Commission of the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida, that:

1. There is hereby assessed by the Town of Sewall's Point, Martin County, Florida, in compliance with Section 943.25(5) Florida Statutes 1981, an additional one and no/100 (\$1.00) dollar, as court costs against every person convicted for a violation of a state penal or criminal statute or convicted of a municipal or county ordinance, where said offense occurred within the Town limits of the Town of Sewall's Point, Martin County, Florida. In addition, one and no/100 (\$1.00) dollar shall be deducted from every bond estreature or forfeited bail bond related to such penal statutes or ordinances. However, no such assessment shall be made against any person convicted for a violation of any state statute, municipal or county ordinance relating to the parking of vehicles.

All such assessments shall be collected by the

appropriate court and shall be remitted to the Town of Sewall's Point and earmarked for law enforcement education and training for members of the police department. The use and expenditure of such funds shall be in accordance with education and training programs for law enforcement personnel as determined by the Chief of Police and in accordance with section 943.14(4), Florida Statutes 1981.

2. This ordinances shall become effective upon its adoption.

SEPARATION.

If any section, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held or declared to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding or invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and it shall be construed to have been the intent of the Board to adopt this Ordinance without such unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative part therein, and the remainder of this Ordinance after the exclusion of such part or parts, shall be deemed and held to be valid as if such part or parts had not been included herein. If this Ordinance or any provision thereof shall be held to be inapplicable to any person, groups of persons, property, kind of property, circumstances or set of circumstances, such holdings shall not affect its applicability to any other person, property or circumstances.

REPEAL.

Town ordinances and Town resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby abolished and repealed to the extent of such conflict.

INCORPORATION IN TOWN CODE.

Provisions of this Ordinance shall be incorporated in the Town Code and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate word, and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention.


EFFECTIVE DATE.

Passed second reading at the regular meeting of the Town Commission held on the 14th day of October, 1981.


