

RESOLUTION NO. 73

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO AND PROVIDING FOR THE PRIMARY AND REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS OF TWO TOWN COMMISSIONERS FOR SAID TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT.

WHEREAS, it is provided by law that Primary and Regular Municipal elections shall be held in the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida, respectively on the fourth Tuesday of February and the first Tuesday in March of each even year, for the purpose of electing Town Commissioners:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT:

Section 1. That a Proclamation shall be issued by the said Town Commission calling the said PRIMARY and REGULAR elections, stating therein where the same shall be held, and naming the different offices to be filled, and to cause the same to be posted at the Town Hall not less than thirty (30) days prior to date of said PRIMARY election.

Section 2. That the Proclamation calling said election shall be substantially in the following form:

PROCLAMATION CALLING MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED BY THE TOWN COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT THAT THE PRIMARY AND REGULAR elections of the Town of Sewall's Point, be, and same are hereby called, and shall be held on Tuesday, February 24, 1970 and Tuesday, March 3, 1970, respectively, as required by law, for the purpose of electing two (2) Town Commissioners.

The polling place for such elections shall be at the Town of Sewall's Point Town Hall.
