RESOLUTION NO. 212

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA, COMMENDING AND HONORING THE HONORABLE BOB GRAHAM, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Governor Bob Graham has recently announced a Save Our Everglades Program, which entails restoration of the Everglades Natural Drainage System from the Kissimmee River Valley to the Everglades National Park; and

WHEREAS, the Commission for the Town of Sewall's Point recognizes the importance of the Everglades Drainage System to the maintenance of the water supply and ecology of the entire Martin County area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA,

That the Town recognizes and commends the wisdom and political courage of Governor Bob Graham in developing and announcing the Save Our Everglades Program, and expresses to the Governor the profound admiration of every resident within the Town for this action, and expresses to the Governor the Town's desire to encourage and support the implementation of the Program, and hereby transmits a copy of this Resolution to the Governor and incorporates this Resolution into the Minutes of the Regular Town Meeting held August 10, 1983.
