

RESOLUTION 223

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA  
AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING EMERGENCY REPAIRS BY THE  
TOWN ENGINEER.

WHEREAS, the Town Commission of the Town of Sewall's  
Point, Florida, believes that a state of emergency exists with  
respect to erosion which is occurring at 16 North Sewall's Point  
Road, and at 26 West High Point Road; and

WHEREAS, by reason of said emergency, the safety and  
welfare of the residents of the Town is immediately threatened;  
and

WHEREAS, the problem of road erosion at the areas  
described above continues to worsen on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, following the Town's normal competitive bidding  
process would unduly delay needed repairs; allow the dangerous  
condition to worsen; and permit continued exposure to a  
hazardous condition,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of the  
Town of Sewall's Point, Florida, that the Town Engineer is  
hereby authorized to let an immediate contract without the  
necessity of advertising and receiving competitive bids for the  
emergency repairs of the two locations described above. The  
Commission further incorporates this resolution into the  
minutes of the regular meeting of the Town Commission on April  
11, 1984.
