RESOLUTION NO. 232

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A PROPERTY TAX LEVY AND STATING THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984 - 1985.

WHEREAS, the Martin County Property Appraiser has certified the taxable value of all property within the jurisdiction of the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission held a duly noticed public hearing on the tentative budget and proposed millage rate at its special meeting on September 10, 1984, at 7:30 P.M., at which the tentative budget was adopted and the proposed millage rate announced; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission first duly advertised in the Stuart News on September 13, 1984, its intent to finally adopt a millage rate and budget at a public hearing on September 17, 1984; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing to finalize the budget and adopt a millage rate was held on September 17, 1984, at 7:30 P.M., at the Town Hall, Sewall's Point, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA:

- 1. The millage rate to be levied against property within the jurisdiction of the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida, shall be \$.9074 per thousand dollars of assessed property value, which exceeds the rolled-back rate by 15%, being the percentage increase in property taxes.
- 2. The Town Clerk is directed to forward this resolution to the Property Appraiser, the Tax Collector, and the Department of Revenue of the State of Florida on or before October 17, 1984.
- 3. The Town Clerk is directed to certify compliance with the provisions of Chapter 200, <u>Florida Statutes</u>, to the Division of Ad Valorem Tax of the Department of Revenue, State of Florida, on or before October 17, 1984.
