

RESOLUTION NO. 243

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA, DECLARING ITEMS SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE TOWN AND PRESCRIBING METHOD OF DISPOSAL.

WHEREAS, Section 2-4 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida, provides procedures for the disposal of assets of the Town which are in excess of the Town's needs; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission has determined that the assets described on the exhibit attached hereto are surplus to the needs of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA, that:

1. The items described on the attached exhibit are declared surplus to the needs of the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida.

2. The Town Clerk and Chief of Police are authorized and directed to advertise for bids in The Stuart News not less than one week nor more than two weeks before receiving the bids, and to dispose of the surplus items to the highest responsible bidder, or, if no bids are received, to dispose of the surplus items by private sale at a reasonable price, with the advice and consent of the Mayor.
