A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA URGING VOTERS TO VOTE IN FAVOR OF THE UPCOMING BOND ISSUE FOR THE JAIL AND COURTHOUSE FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Town Commission for the Town of Sewall's Point has determined that it would be in the best interests of Town and County residents for the proposed new county courthouse facility to be kept in downtown Stuart; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission for the Town of Sewall's Point is aware that there is a pressing need for the construction of a new jail facility; and

WHEREAS, there is an upcoming referendum election at which the proposed bond issues to finance the new courthouse and jail facilities will be put to the voters of Martin County; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission of the Town of Sewall's Point has determined that it would be in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Sewall's Point and the residents of Martin County if the bond issues were to pass and the new facilities constructed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Commission of the Town of Sewall's Point that it supports and urges all voters to vote favorably on the bond issues that will finance the new courthouse and jail construction.


