FOR HEROIC ACTION**

**WHEREAS**, ON APRIL 26, 2015, POLICE OFFICER ANTHONY BONO RESPONDED TO 555 NE OCEAN BLVD. WHERE A FEMALE WAS IN THE OCEAN ATTEMPTING TO COMMIT SUICIDE BY DROWNING, ON THE ONE-YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF HER HUSBAND'S DEATH; AND

**WHEREAS**, OFFICER BONO ALERTLY OBSERVED THE CONDITION OF THE FEMALE AND PROMPTLY AND COURAGEOUSLY RUSHED TO HER RESCUE WITHOUT REGARD FOR HIS PERSONAL SAFETY; AND

**WHEREAS**, BY REASON OF THE HEROIC ACTION, COMPASSION AND PROFESSIONALISM OF OFFICER BONO, THE IMMINENT THREAT OF DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY WAS AVERTED AND THE FEMALE WAS SAVED; AND

**WHEREAS**, THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA WISHES TO RECOGNIZE AND COMMEND THE ACTIONS OF OFFICER BONO;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, THAT THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA,

**HEREBY OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZES AND COMMENDS**

**THE HEROISM OF
