

ORDINANCE No. 17

(Repeal of Occupational License Ordinance)

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 5  
SAID ORDINANCE NO. 5 BEING AN EMERGENCY  
ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF  
LICENSES FOR CERTAIN BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS  
AND OCCUPATIONS IN THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT,  
FLORIDA; ESTABLISHING A RATE OF OCCUPATIONAL  
LICENSES TAX ON SAID BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS  
AND OCCUPATIONS; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE  
VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY FOR THE PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE  
AND SETTING FORTH THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S  
POINT, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That from and after the 30th day of September, A.D., 1958  
Ordinance No. 5, being the Occupational Ordinance for the Town  
of Sewall's Point, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That from and after the date that this Ordinance becomes  
effective, it shall not be necessary for any person, firm or corporation  
engaged in or carrying on any business, profession or occupation in the  
Town of Sewall's Point, Florida, to have an occupational license in order  
to transact such business.

This Ordinance will take effect on September 30, 1958.
