

ORDINANCE NO. 48

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA, TO PROMOTE THE HEALTH, SAFETY, MORALS AND GENERAL WELFARE OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA, BY FACILITATING A PROMPT AND EFFICIENT REPAIR OF THE SEWALL'S POINT ROAD, A VITAL ROUTE OF TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA:

Section 1. In accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida, Section 2.01 of Ordinance # 45, dated 9/14/66, the Charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

The maturity date of said notes shall be:

- First note - October 1, 1968 in amount of \$4,000.00
- Second note - October 1, 1969 in amount of \$4,000.00
- Third note - October 1, 1970 in amount of \$4,000.00
- Fourth note - October 1, 1971 in amount of \$4,000.00
- Fifth note - October 1, 1972 in amount of \$4,000.00

Section 2. An emergency exists for the passage of this Ordinance in that same is necessary for the immediate presentation of public peace, property, health and safety of the people of the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida.

Section 3. The other terms of Ordinance # 45 shall remain in full force and effect.
