

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE LAWS OF FLORIDA REGARD VIOLATION OF THE MISDEMEANOR LAWS OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA WITHIN THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT BY REFERENCE TO STATE STATUTES.

WHEREAS, the Town Commission is interested in protecting the citizens of the Town of Sewall's Point, and preserving the peace and dignity due them as citizens of said Town, and

WHEREAS, it is in their judgment the best protection would be to preserve to them the same protection as granted under state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT:

Section 1. That no person shall commit within the Town any act which is, or shall be, recognized by the Laws of the State of Florida, as a misdemeanor.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage as required by law.

PASSED first reading at meeting of Town Commission held on the 3rd day of December, 1967.

PASSED second reading and became a law at the regular meeting of the Town Commission held on the 13th day of January, 1968
