

ORDINANCE NO. 55

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MAXIMUM PENALTY UPON CONVICTION OF THE VIOLATION OF THE BUILDING CODE, PLUMBING CODE, OR ELECTRICAL CODE WITHIN THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT.

WHEREAS, the Town Commission is interested in instituting measures to provide for the enforcement of its building, plumbing and electrical codes, and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission feels that it is for the best interest of the Town to provide penalties for the violation of said building, plumbing, and electrical codes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any provisions of the building, plumbing, or electrical codes of the Town of Sewall's Point.

Section 2. Any person convicted of violating any provisions of any of the codes contained in Section 1 of this Ordinance may be fined not to exceed \$100.00 or in prison for not more than 30 days.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage as required by law.

PASSED first reading at meeting of Town Commission held on the 13 day of November, 1968.

PASSED second reading and became a law at the regular meeting of the Town Commission held on the 11 day of December, 1968.
