

ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT,
FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR PURSUIT BEYOND THE
TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF THE TOWN BY POLICE
OFFICERS OF THE TOWN.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE
OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Pursuit Beyond Territorial Limits of Town. Any
police officer of the Town of Sewall's Point, where any person violates
a Town ordinance or commits a misdemeanor within the territorial limits
of Town, or where any police officer of the Town has reasonable grounds
to believe that a person found within the territorial limits of the Town
has violated a Town ordinance or had committed a misdemeanor within
the Territorial limits of the Town or had committed a felony, may, in
fresh and continuous pursuit whenever necessary to effect the arrest
of such person, pursue such person outside of the Town to any point
within Martin County, Florida, and there arrest him.

Section 2. This Ordinance will take effect immediately upon its
passage as required by law.

PASSED first reading of Town Commissioners held on the 10
day of September, 1969.

PASSED second reading and became a law at the regular meeting of
the Town Commission held on the 8 day of October, 1969.
