

ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE IMPRISONMENT OF OFFENDERS AGAINST ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN AS AUTHORIZED AND DEFINED BY THE 31ST PARAGRAPH OF SECTION 1, ARTICLE II, OF THE CHARTER OF SEWALL'S POINT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SEWALL'S POINT, FLORIDA:

Section 1. When any person who has been found guilty by the Municipal Judge of the Town of Sewall's Point and is fined a certain sum of money and costs, the Municipal Judge is hereby directed to provide for the imprisonment of the offenders against said Ordinance, said imprisonment to be in the County Jail of Martin County, Florida, and be at hard labor on the streets or other public works of the Town until such fines and costs adjudged against them by the Judicial authority of the Municipality are paid.

Section 2. This Ordinance does not in any way prohibit or restrict the Judicial authorities of the Municipality to impose a straight jail sentence against an offender of any of the Ordinances of the Town.

Section 3. The amount to be credited to such person's fines and costs on account of said fines and costs for each day's work for each day in jail shall be ^{not less than} \$ 3.33 per day, in the discretion of this court.

Section 4. All laws or parts of laws in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take place immediately upon becoming a law.

PASSED at first reading at the Town Commission held on the 8 day of October, 1969.

PASSED at second reading and became a law at regular meeting of Town Commission held on the 12 day of November, 1969.

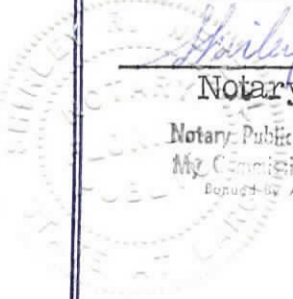
