



Town of Sewall's Point – Extension of State of Local Emergency

On March 16, 2020, the Town Commission of the Town of Sewall's Point adopted Resolution No. 883 declaring a State of Local Emergency in the Town of Sewall's Point in response to the public emergency that COVID-19 poses. In accordance with Resolution No. 883, the period of the State of Local Emergency is for seven (7) days and may be extended every seven (7) days thereafter by a "Designated Town Official." The "Designated Town Official" is defined in section 16-2(b) of the Town's Code of Ordinances to mean the Mayor, or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor, or in the absence of the Mayor and Vice Mayor, the Town Manager, or in the absence of the Mayor, Vice Mayor, and Town Manager, the Chief of Police.

Accordingly, I Frank Fender, the Town Mayor of the Town of Sewall's Point, Florida, hereby extend the period of the State of Local Emergency for seven (7) days until the 11th day of May, 2020. This Extension of the State of Local Emergency will be posted at Town Hall and on the Town's website.
